World Language - 2 credits: ${ }^{* *}$ Must be in the SAME Foreign Language**
Lifetime Wellness - 1 credit
Physical Education - .5 credit
Fine Art - 1 credit
Focus Elective Pathway Courses - 3 credits: Business, Technology, or Advanced Studies
Total Credits Required for Graduation $\mathbf{=} \mathbf{2 2} .0$ credits
